After two years of cancellation, the French Market in Killarney Heights successfully returned in 2022 and set a new attendance record. An incredible number of visitors flocked to enjoy a piece of France.

We do this by bringing multicultural families together around a unique bilingual learning experience.


Our values are: Ouverture, Partage, Dynamism, Genuine & Growth.

The Bilingual Program

From Kindergarten to Year 6, Killarney Heights Public School (KHPS) students enrolled in the bilingual program (85% of the students in 2022) benefit from a unique learning program.

KHPS students are taught part of the the NSW curriculum in French by native French-speaking qualified teachers, working hand in hand with the classroom teacher.

The program allows French background speakers to enhance and maintain their bilingualism in French/English. Students with minimal or no prior exposure to French are taught French vocabulary and grammar to eventually become fluent in all daily matters by the end of Year 6.

Since 2012, FANS bilingual program at Killarney Heights Public School is awarded the "Label FrancEducation", an official recognition by the French Ministries of Education and Foreign Affairs of its excellence.

Through its partnership with FANS, KHPS was invited to become a founding member of the Australian Association of French English Bilingual Schools when it was formed in 2015. This network of 15 bilingual or binational schools offers annual professional development workshops dedicated to teaching in a bilingual setting in Australia which provides support, new perspectives and insights for our team.
